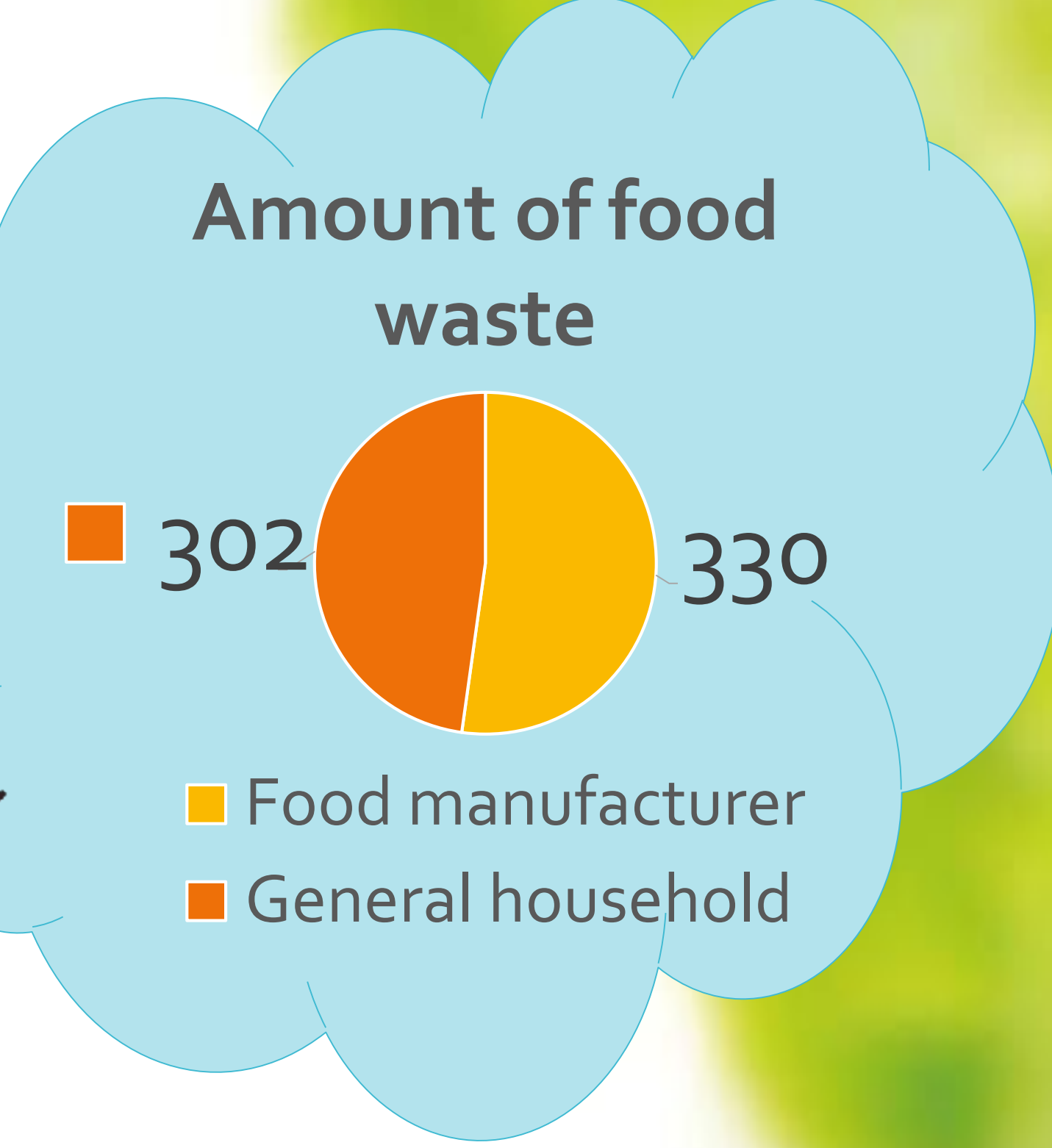




How we can decrease food waste in Japan

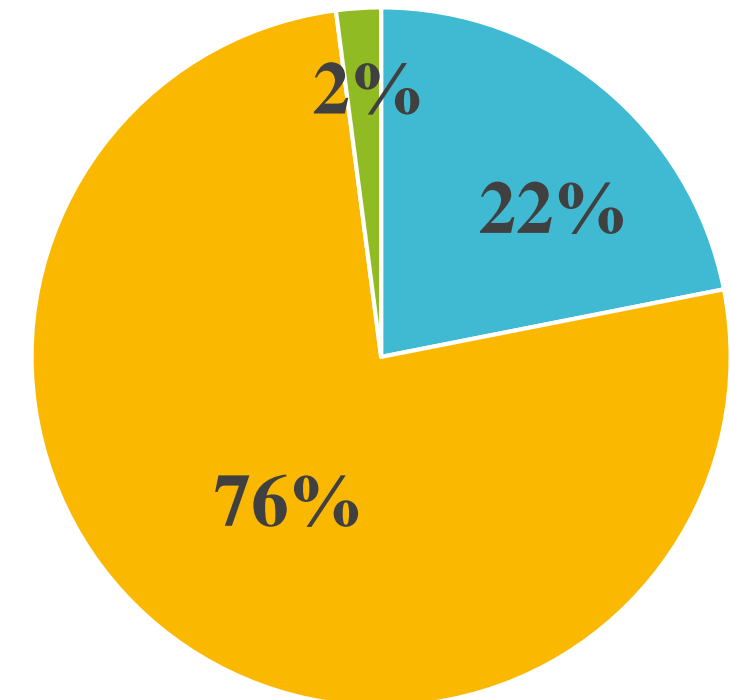

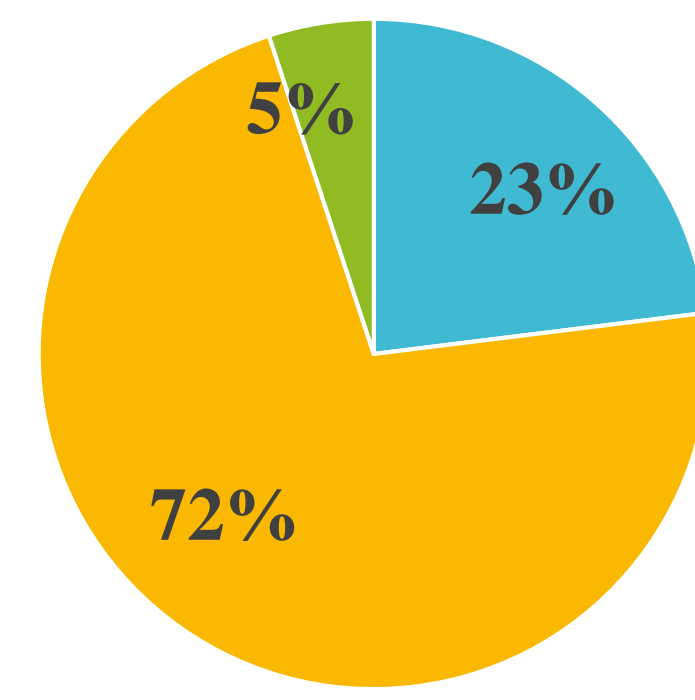

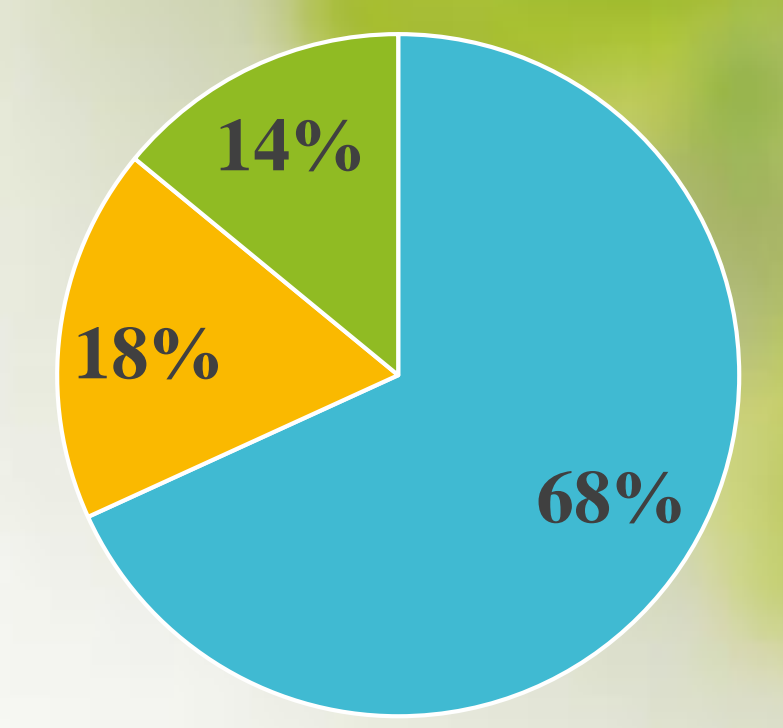

✓ Changing the law is **difficult**



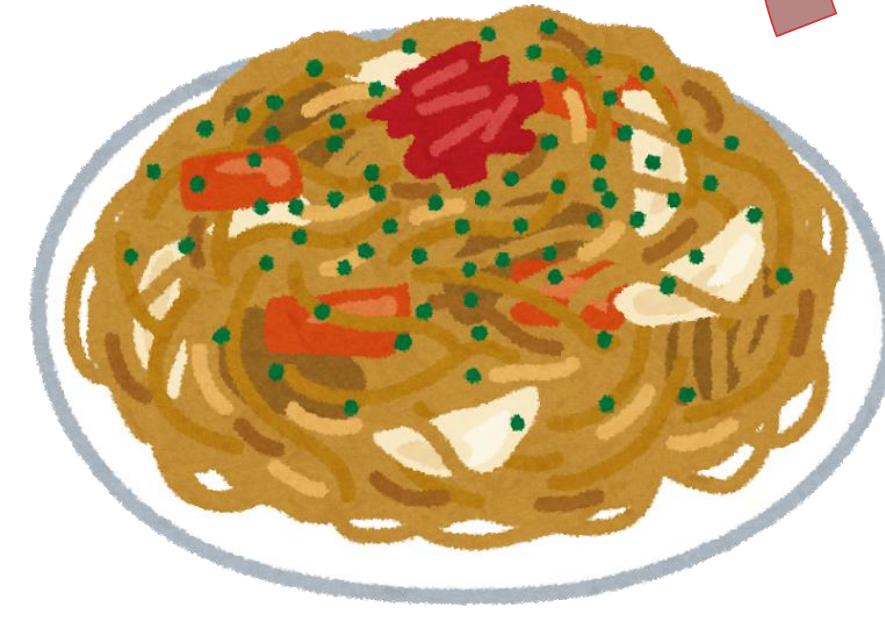

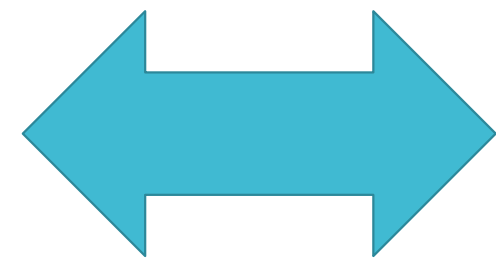
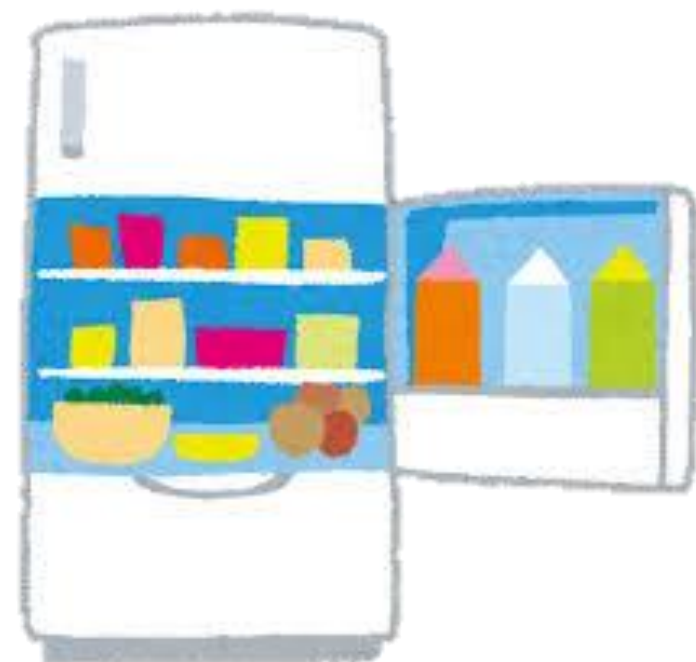
Submit a **letter of demand** to Noboribetsu-city with a proposal.
