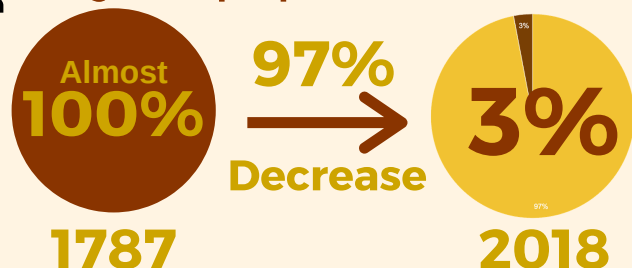


What is Essential for Aboriginal People to have the Better Life in Australia

What does the government do?

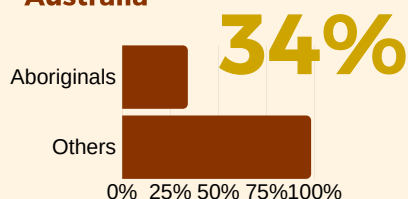
- Indigenous Scholarship System
