Few platform screen doors

Not Barrier-free

- Undeveloped sidewalks
- No timetable with braille
- Few low floor buses
- Outdated ticket dispensers and fare collection machine

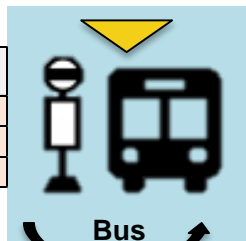


Easy Card
