- 2. Not all students should be required to acquire the practical English at high school age.

Analysis


- University Connection System Reform Meeting,

"From the viewpoint of developing the ability to play an active role globally, we must evaluate all the four skills of English including "writing" and "speaking", whereas we currently evaluate reading and listening only.[1]"

- Questionnaire results:

98% : Practical English needed for our society 96%: η for *my* life 80% : Study English hard for the future Most important ability : SPEAKING 2nd most important : LISTENING. \rightarrow Hypothesis rejected

- Found Agreements in Student & Social Needs. \rightarrow <u>Universally applicable</u>?
- Ambiguous, general terms to describe their motivations.



Analysis by KH Coder: "Why important?"

Results

- Hypothesis 1 was unsupported. ("Students don't want the High-level English education, which is required by society")
- Students only had ambiguous motivation to acquire practical English.

Proposals and Discussion

- Careful analysis needed : <u>Real</u> individual needs based on personal needs or intrinsic motivation?
- Too much discussion on the "practicality" dimension.
