#### Advantage 1: Solve Domestic Labor Shortage


According to the Cabinet Office:

The declining of production-age population will accelerate towards 2030.





Reception of immigrant workers will solve the lack of workers and a hollowing-out of industry. It will give good effect on the future of Japan's Industry and economy.






#### Advantage 2: Mitigate Burden of National Debt

Today, even if the foreign laborers are applied with the minimum wage, the employers are strictly requesting adequate work performance to the laborers.






### Disadvantage 2: Increase in Crime Rate
