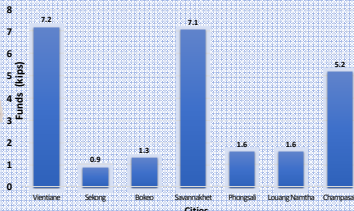

4 students can go to school from last year's activities

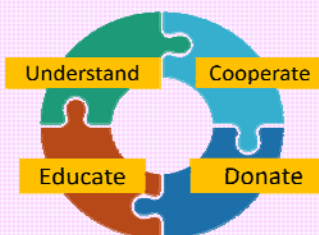
