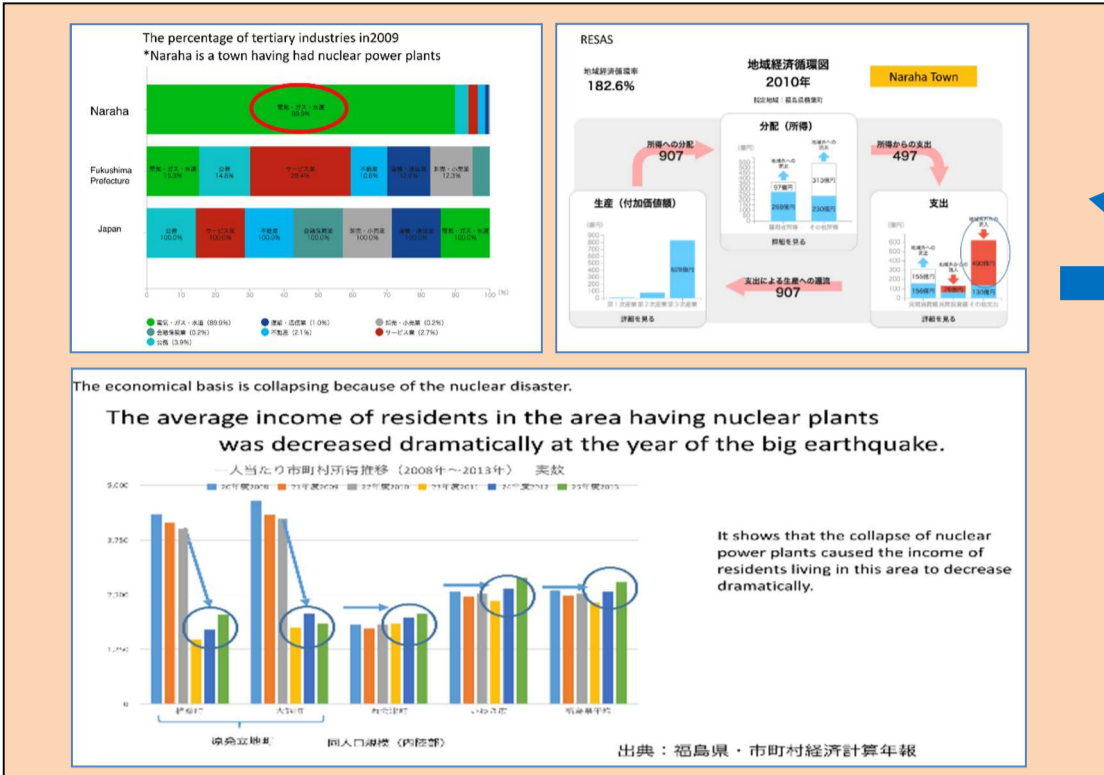
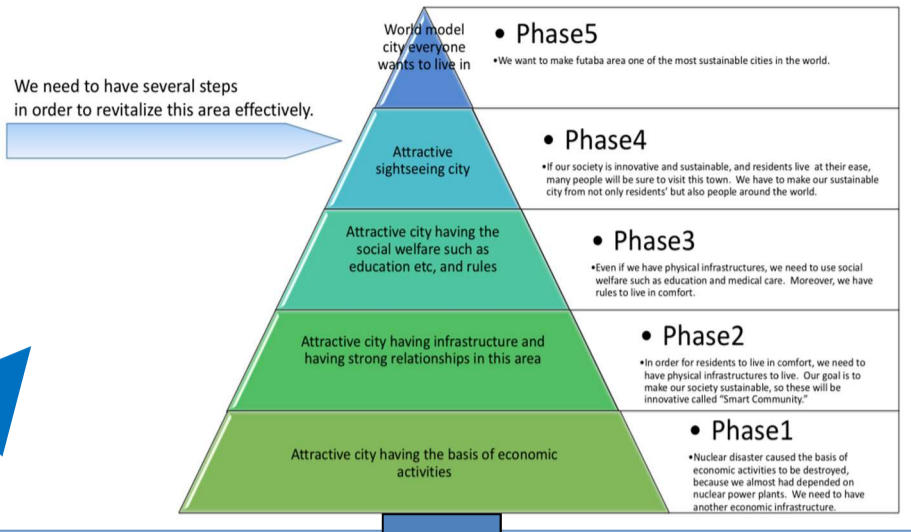


① Introduction

6 years have passed and several changes have taken place.

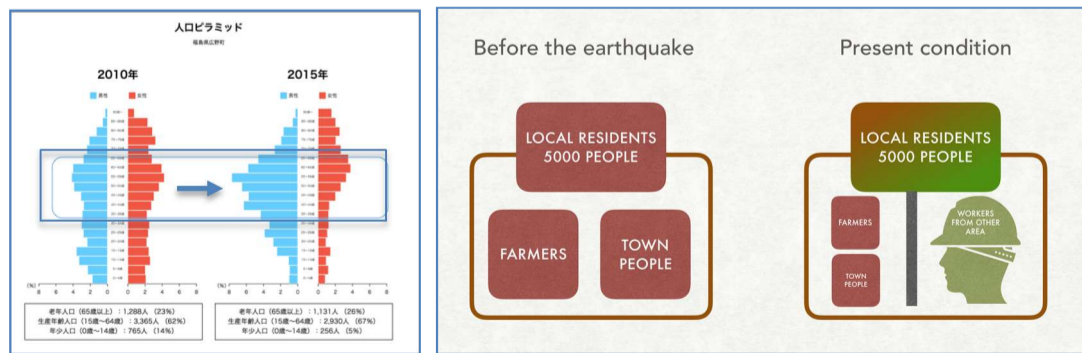
- Local residents are returning

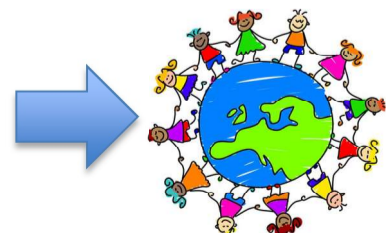


④ Recommendation
