Current Situation

Storage at School



• Our school stores enough supplies for about 1,000 people to survive for 3 days

For each person
Water : 3ℓ × 3days = 9ℓ

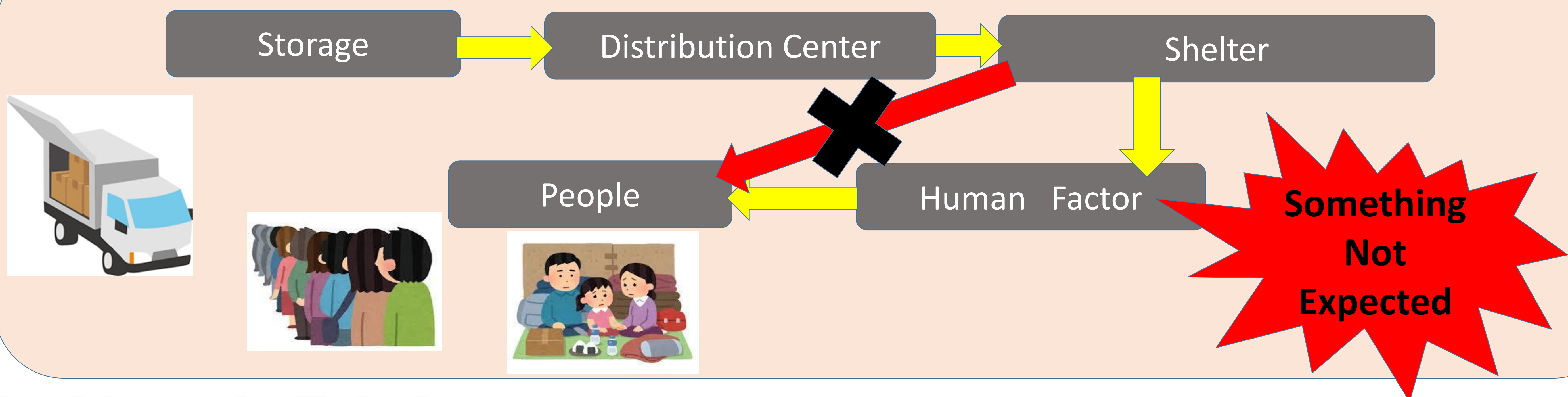
Food : 3meals × 3days = 9meals

Storage Centers in Kochi



- Kochi prefecture designates 8 storage centers
- They will send food and water to the distribution centers
- Roads for delivery will be repaired first

No decision-making experience



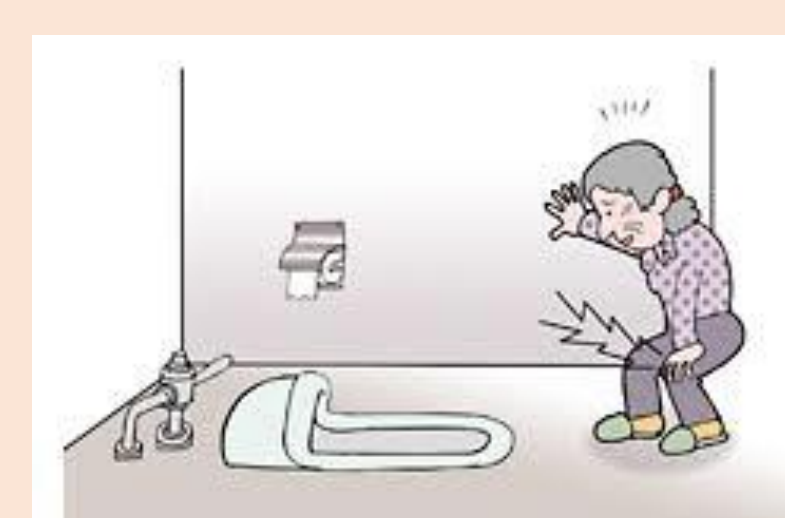
- People didn't have enough experience making decisions within their community

No close connections & No care

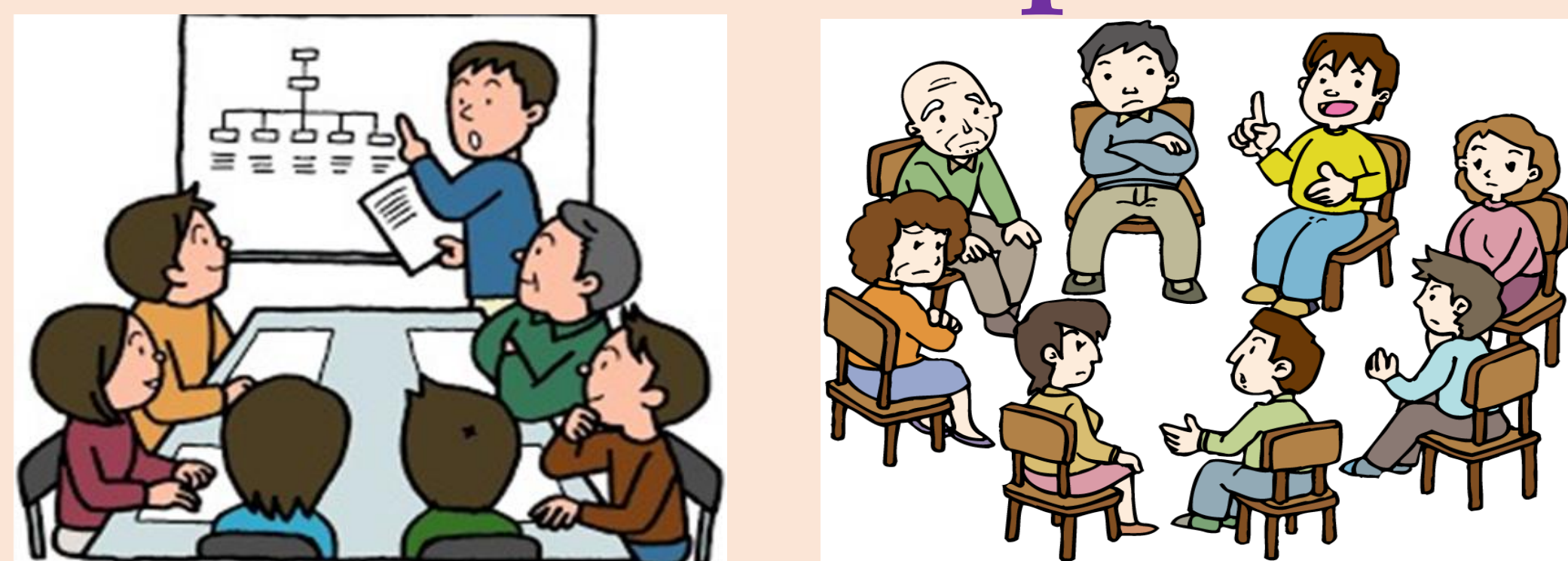
- The community members didn't know each other

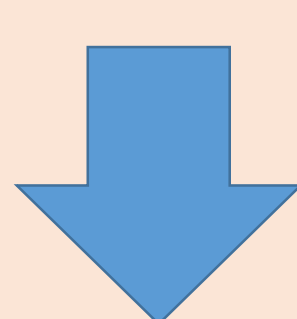
