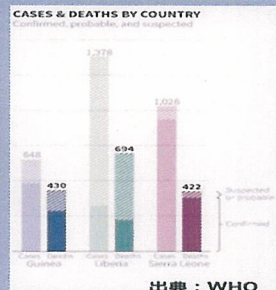

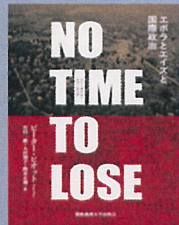

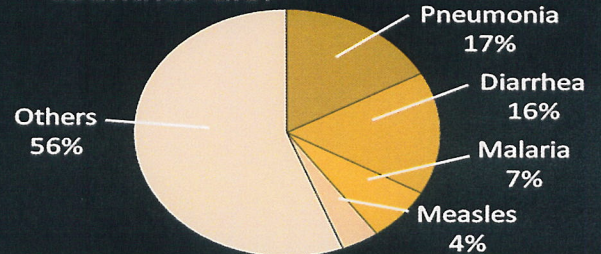

- how to prevent infectious diseases

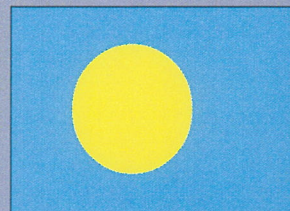


Developed countries and the international organizations mainly UNICEF perform distribution of medical supplies or the financial support.

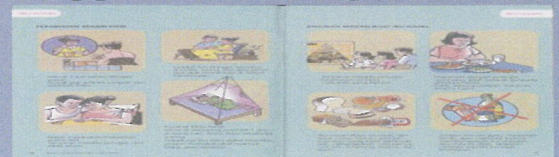
